
# OWH Grant Mission

African American churches have a proven track record of reaching hardto- reach populations to disseminate key prevention messages and to shape cultural norms, specifically female leaders in the church.




### **The Trinity Project Goals**

- ❖To eliminate HIV/AIDS related stigma that often inhibit women and girls in faith-based communities from seeking testing or accessing care
- \*Develop/demonstrate gender-responsive, peer-led prevention education intervention that is culturally, and developmentally appropriate
- Establish and expand a coalition of services and community linkages for <u>ensuring gender-responsive</u> HIV/AIDS/<u>STD services</u>

# Targeted Geographical Areas

- A high HIV and/or STD prevalence among women and girls
- A deficit of HIV/AIDS/STD services
- Disproportionately impacted by health disparities

- 10 Churches (2<sup>nd</sup> year)
- 10 Churches (3<sup>rd</sup> year)

2 Ambassadors per church6-10 Participants per group

## **Trinity Training**

- Implementation Process- Adult Ambassadors:
  - Project Kick-Off Meeting
  - Four weekly trainings
  - Town Hall Meeting
  - Graduation Ceremony
  - \* Recruitment
  - Implementation

# Trinity Intervention Sessions

- Trinity Curriculum Model (Adaptation of the CDC SISTA Intervention)
- All Sessions are once or twice a week
- Sessions are for five consecutive weeks
- Approximately 2 hours per session
- Participants must complete all 5 sessions
- New participant recruitment begins each quarter within your congregation
